




- 1: 2 x Platform Tops (MDF)
- 2: Sprue of White Concrete Base
 - (a) Concrete End Support Blocks Qty:2
 - (b) Concrete Centre Support Blocks Qty:9
 - (c) Concrete End Support Beams Qty:4
 - (d) Concrete Centre Support Beams Qty:6
- 3: Sprue of Grey Metal Grids
- 4: Self Adhesive Platform Sticker Tops




1 - Removing Components from Sprue


Carefully using a sharp knife, with the sprue on a cutting mat or suitable surface, remove the Concrete Base (2) & Grey Metal Grid (3) components from the sprue.

















2 - Assembling Base Structure









Dry fit first, ensuring that the textured side of each piece is facing outwards. Please note that the End Support Blocks (2a) are different to the Center Support Blocks (2b) and should be orientated at each end of the platform as shown in the picture below



Once you're happy with the dry test fitment, apply glue to each Base Support in-turn and re-insert the Top Beams firmly into place.


After the glue has comepletely dried, rotate the platform upside down for the next step.






3 - Inserting Lower Metal Grids


Apply a small amount of glue to the top edge of each Metal Grid (3) and slide fully into the slots along the underside of the platform. Repeat with the Metal Grids at each end.














4 - Preparing Platform Tops



Place the MDF Platform Top Pieces (1) on a cutting mat or suitable surface. Using a sharp knife, carefully remove each top piece.





Ensure any remains of the sprue tabs are removed from the ends of the platform tops using a file. It is recommended to apply some grey paint to the side and rear edges of each platform top piece, then allow to dry thoroughly before moving to the next step.


5 - Platform Top Stickers


Place one MDF Platform Top Piece (1), top-side upwards on a flat surface. Carefully peel one Platform Top Sticker (4) from the sheet and align a rear corner of the sticker with the rear corner of the top.





Ensure the back edge is aligned along the whole length of the platform top. Smooth the sticker along the top ensuring there are no creases or air bubbles. Note that the sticker will overhang the front of the platform top.





5 - Platform Top Stickers cont.

Turn the platform top upside down of a clean and flat surface. It is recommended to apply a small amount of glue along the front edge of the underside of the platform top.





Lift the rear of the platform top and rotate forwards. Ensure that the front edge of the platform remains in contact with the work surface, slowly rotate over so the sticker folds itself around the front edge of the platform top. Ensure the sticker is smooth along and around the edge of the platform top and press down firmly. Leave to dry.








Take care to keep your hands clean and not get glue on the platform top surface.






6 - Attach Platform Tops

The platform tops are fitted with the back of each top of aligning with the back and the ends of the assembled platform support structure.

Apply a small amount of glue to the top of the structure and attach the platform tops. Take care to keep your hands clean and not get glue on the platform top surface.





The platform is now ready to put on your layout.
